- Not attempt to conceal oversights or errors to lessen responsibility of mistakes
- Present contracts that are sound and fair to all parties; contractor, principal and owners
- Treat with the strictest confidence the prices, sub-bids and other information furnished by sub-contractors and suppliers
- Not divulge any business secrets or confidential knowledge of principal's business affairs
- Under no circumstances be guilty of undignified or questionable professional conduct or behavior that could unfavorably reflect upon the Professional Construction Estimators Association and/or the Association's individual members
