Please feel free to bring your own firearms (anything up to but not including .50 BMG.)

The range has targets and also they have some guns available for rental if you do not have your own.

Everyone will be required to watch a safety video and sign a Waiver in order to participate in the shooting. The

video and waiver can be completed in advance by clicking on the link. <u>Safety Video and Waiver</u>.

A couple of things to remember:

- Bring your own firearms. All firearms need to be secured until you reach the firing range.
- Bring your own ammo. All ammo must be brass casing. You can purchase ammo from the range, but they are typically more expensive then you can buy elsewhere.
- Ear and Eye protection must be worn at all times when in the range. Again, these can be purchased at the range, if necessary.
- This event will not have any alcohol available during the dinner or after.
